PRIOR TO THE MEETING IN BUENOS AIRES

Throughout the entire beginning of the year, the ICG continued its monthly discussion meetings on the twists, turns, and end of analysis, which resulted in the choice of a topic for the meeting, **The pass to the analyst.** It continued as well to carry out its **statutory tasks**:

The IAC composed at the beginning the year published the list of AMS 2022, which you will find in the addenda.

The cartels of the pass continued to meet in accordance with the finished passes.

The registry of requests, nominations, passes in progress: the register through July may be found in the addenda.

In addition, besides the Meeting, it took care of preparations for the Symposium on the Pass and for the Assembly of the School.

THE MEETING OF THE SCHOOL JUNE 30, 2022

For the ICG, this was the occasion of its first face to face meeting since the beginning of its mandate. It was a moment at once joyful and fruitful for each one. From this emerged the decision to resume whenever possible the necessary travel for face to face. Thus the ICG unanimously decided to hold its November meeting and that of the current Cartels of the Pass in Paris, Friday, November 25, 2022, on the occasion of the Journées nationales of the EPFCL-France.

Its title **The pass to the analyst,** brings us back to what was Lacan's intention regarding this pass, namely the moment of emergence of the necessary desire to pass to the act of the analyst, and it has allowed us to interrogate its relevance.

The contributions from this Meeting will be published in Wunsch 23 which is in preparation.

RESULTS OF THE ASSEMBLY

a. An addition to the internal rules of the ICG

Paragraph 2.4 devoted to the passers received the following addition after discussion in the symposium:

« If a dispositif lacks passers who speak the language of a candidate for the pass, the secretary may reach out to the ICG which holds the notebook of passes, in order to be informed of other dispositifs that have passers speaking this language ».

The updated version of the rule will be transmitted to Lucile Cognard for archiving on the site.

b. An Addendum to the Principles for a School.

The proposal by the ICG to inscribe its text on the distinction Member of the Forum - Member of the School as an addendum to the Principles was submitted to a vote following debate and was overwhelmingly accepted: 100% approved.

The text was made more precise on one point.

Where it said: (...) the creation of a forum requires only that there be colleagues of whom one knows them to be simply 'interested' by psychoanalysis (...), the discussion resulted in adding:

« (...) the creation of a forum requires only that there be colleagues of whom one knows them to be, at a minimum, simply 'interested' by psychoanalysis ».

This update will also be transmitted to Lucile Cognard.

RECAP OF THE CAOE'S INITIATIVES

The CAOE comprising part of the ICG, all of its choices have been debated within the ICG. This is the why we make note of them here.

The reports from the prior ICG during the AG of the School 2020 on the function of the CAOE addressed and stimulated a debate within the current CAOE. Elisabete Thamer, who prepared the report from the CAOE (2018-2020) wrote:

« The work carried out by the CAOE has principally been linked to the elaboration of *Wunsch* and to the work of translation, which took up a good part of the time. All of this led to a concern, which was transmitted to the ICG, regarding the need to rethink this instance of the School, so that it could be more efficient in attaining the objectives given to it, in accordance with the *Guiding Principles* of the School, where we read that this instance is tasked with assuring debate in the School at the international level, the coordination of its activities, Seminars and Meetings (Journées), which must « bring into existence the work of the School at the international level» (Report sent via the IF list 09/18/2020).

The decision of the CAOE 2020-2022 has therefore been to activate in a new way the objectives set forth for this instance, in order to make more effective the international work of the School. For this purpose, it proposed the Intercontinental and Bilingual School Cartels of the CAOE.

Their composition and their objectives have been well defined in **three successive letters.** Only the third of these appears again in this edition of \acute{E} chos

Two Cartel Days were planned, February 5th and the next one for September 17th, this time with translation into our five languages. The **program** has been shared over the list and we reprint it here in the addenda, accompanied for the first time by the Catalogue of Intercontinental and Bilingual Cartels of the School, up to July 2022.

In addition, we have the pleasure of announcing, for the first time, the creation of an a-periodic Bulletin, « Notebooks of the Intercontinental and Bilingual Cartels of the School » of which the first issue will appear after the meeting of September 17th. It will include the contributions from this meeting and the up-to-date catalogue of cartels.

• Preparation of Wunsch 23 for the end of the year

The summary of this bulletin of the ICG which is *Wunsch* generally includes, beyond the contributions from the Meeting of the School, those of members of the ICG. Our ICG wishing to avoid the juxtaposition of 17 contributions by its 17 membres, opted at the meeting of Buenos Aires for a new formula. After two years of work by 17, the group divided into **four short-term cartels, co**mposed by drawing lots. Each one will submit, no later than mid-November, its contribution to *Wunsch* on one of the points worked on during these two years, and which have been recorded in the minutes of each session.

This issue will also include all the documents produced to be preserved.

III. 3rd letter from the CAOE on the Intercontinental and Bilingual Cartels

From CAOE 2020-2021

To the members of the School

Dear Colleagues,

This is our third message concerning the project for a network of international cartels. It is in response to the various questions addressed to us during the time of the three current dispositifs of the guarantee and which have led us to revisit and further clarify the planned arrangements.

These cartels will be intercontinental and bilingual. This is their definition. They will bring together members of the School from two different continents and speaking at least two different languages, for the purpose of promoting, as we have said, new and multiple links towards the work on psychoanalysis in intention, not only at the level of the international and national instances where they exist already, but at the very basis of the School, engaging there the entirety of the Members of the School who have not yet participated in the instances of direction. They will find in this network a space where their work will be able to have a new resonance, eventually through a bulletin, meetings, inter cartels and other forms yet to be invented.

Thus we also hope to achieve more clarity about the distinction between the work of a Forum and School work—a distinction which is at origin constitutive of our

ensemble and moreover corresponds to two different modes of admission, each with its own criteria which have been constantly debated since the beginnings of the School and which deserve to remain under scrutiny over time.

Moreover, as we have said, for the work to be possible, in each cartel only one language will be spoken and that presupposes, let us specify, that the members of the cartel have in common one of the five languages of our community, those in which we send you this message. These cartels will therefore be bilingual in their composition, its members speaking at least two different languages as already said, but one of these two languages will not necessarily be spoken: depending on the case, the work may be done in any one of our five languages, English, Spanish, French, Italian or Portuguese.

Last point: for the launch of these cartels we indicated that we would solicit members of local or international instances, assuming that they would be directly concerned with this initiative. It should be noted that this was not, however, to invite them to form a cartel among themselves but on the contrary to invite them to seek members of the School they do not yet know. We also know from experience that the differences between the members of a cartel, differences in age, training, culture, are a plus that stimulates work.

Finally, many questions will no doubt still arise. We have therefore planned that each member of the CAOE will soon bring together, via Zoom, the members of the School in his/her area to collect the questions still pending, elaborate them, and then allow this network to be put in place quickly.
